In a unanimous decision, the Fatality Review Committee has determined that the death of [REDACTED] should not be charged to the mining industry. The MSHA investigation revealed that [REDACTED] was employed by Securitas Services USA, Inc., as a security guard at the Rend Lake mine. About 8:00 am on October 9, 2007, a mine employee found [REDACTED] body on the floor in the mine warehouse. Another mine employee who is a Paramedic checked [REDACTED] for vital signs and found none. MSHA investigators did not find any environmental or work-related hazards that could have contributed to [REDACTED] death. The Coroner's Certificate of Death indicates that the cause of death was acute myocardial infarction and the manner of death was natural. An autopsy was not performed.

Based on the Coroner's Certificate of Death and the results of MSHA's investigation, the committee members concluded that [REDACTED] died from natural causes and his death should not be charged to the mining industry.
