




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

SUBJECT: Chargeability Review Committee Decision

Decision: Not chargeable

In a unanimous decision, the Chargeability Review Committee has determined that the death of [REDACTED] not be charged to the mining industry. [REDACTED] a 48 year old truck driver, was awaiting the start of his shift when he was found unconscious on the ground near his truck in the loading area. He was transported by ambulance to a local hospital where he was declared dead.

The death certificate indicated that the manner of death was natural and that the cause of death was cardiac arrest due to coronary artery disease and a history of a past myocardial infarction). An autopsy was not performed.

Based on the findings of death certificate and the MSHA investigation; the committee members concluded that [REDACTED] died due to natural causes and that his death should not be charged to the mining industry.
