MSHA's investigation was conducted between September 04, 2015 and October 07, 2015. No physical or environmental factors that could have contributed to the death were identified. The autopsy and death certificate found the manner of death to be natural, and the immediate cause of death was listed as hypertensive atherosclerotic heart disease.

Based on these findings, the committee members concluded that Mr. 2002 's death should not be charged to the mining industry.
