I have reviewed the investigative report in the death of should not be charged to the mining industry. Was operating a vehicle that was spotted by a Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation officer while trespassing in the area of a dam on mine property. When the vehicle traveled from a road on the mine property to a county roadway the officer pursued the vehicle. The pursuit was suspended when the trespassing truck left the county road and traveled back onto mine property. The officer was notified later of a rollover accident involving the deceased's vehicle. A male passenger ran approximately two miles to seek help.

The accident occurred on the mine site; however the persons involved were trespassers and did not have permission to be on the mine site. No death certificate or autopsy report was provided. Based on MSHA's investigation, I have determined that the death of was not due to mine related work activities and should not be charged to the mining industry.
