Roadside Reflectors

Miners driving along mine haul roads may encounter limited visibility at night, or from fog or other weather conditions. These conditions are similar to driving along our nation's highways.



Roadside reflectors have been in use for many years to help drivers identify the road boundaries. One suggestion for increasing visibility would be for mine operators to install reflectors along the mine haul roads.



These reflectors are available commercially and can even be purchased from a local hardware store. They are generally inexpensive and greatly increase visibility. These reflectors are easy to install and coupled with well installed and maintained berms and road signs can save a life.
