2. LETTER FROM CURRENT EMPLOYER

Please be specific about what type of work you have performed, and how it related to electrical work and mining experience. **Include such details as low/Medium/high voltages and number of phases you have worked with, what electrical equipment you have worked on and maintained, such as underground mine permissibility, circuit breakers repaired, wiring of transformers, motor controllers, resistance grounding systems, etc.** Wording such as "worked on electrical equipment," "was a master electrician," "electricians helper" "rebuilt substations," "ran conduit," "have worked at a mine 10 years," "assisted electricians" needs to be **fully** explained regarding what electrical work you did when performing the task.
