Decision: Non-chargeable

In a unanimous decision the Fatality Review Committee has determined that the death of the decedent should be non-chargeable to the mining industry. The death certificate finding that the decedent succumbed to an "Aorta aneurysm dissection" was a decisive factor in the final committee decision. The employee, a 37 year old front end loader operator, was overweight and took medications for both diabetes and hypertension. He had complained of chest pain and nausea just prior to being transported to a local hospital. The employee was performing his normal work duties at the time of the incident and research by a committee member found it not likely that the aorta aneurysm could be caused by work activity.
