In a unanimous decision the Fatality Review Committee has determined that the death of the decedent should be non-chargeable to the mining industry. The immediate cause of death on the certificate of death was "Atherosclerotic Cardiovascular Disease." The certificate also indicated that the deceased suffered from hypertension, gout and renal insufficiency. The decedent a 52 year old crusher operator, had removed a blockage from a crusher. He walked up three flights of stairs to the control room and restarted the crusher. He was found unconscious soon after. The committee members felt that the finding from the certificate of death was the deciding factor in their decision.
