Decision: Not Chargeable

In a unanimous decision, the Fatality Review Committee has determined that the death of [REDACTED] should not be charged to the mining industry. MSHA's accident investigation determined that [REDACTED] body was found by a telephone company employee near the highwall of the Talmage Quarry. [REDACTED] was not an employee of

the mine and was not authorized to be on mine property. The Autopsy Report states that the cause of [REDACTED] death was "Gunshot Wound to Chest," and the manner of death was "Suicide." Based on the Autopsy Report, the committee members concluded that [REDACTED] death was a suicide and should not be charged to the mining industry.
