I reviewed the investigative report in the death of and determined it should not be charged to the mining industry. Mr. Mr. a 58-year-old fire boss, was pronounced dead on July 15, 2017 shortly after transport to the emergency room at Raleigh General Hospital. Previously, on July 12, 2017, Mr. had undergone surgery at Raleigh General Hospital to repair a work related inguinal hernia. An autopsy was not conducted. However, the medical examiner performed an external examination and completed the death certificate for Mr. The death certificate states that the manner of death was natural, and that hypertensive cardiovascular disease was a significant condition contributing to the death.
