I reviewed the investigative report in the death of determined it should not be charged to the mining industry. a 58-year-old contract driller, was observed in distress next to his vehicle. He complained of chest and neck pain, and the mine foreman contacted 911 for assistance. Emergency medical personnel arrived and transported to the hospital. At the hospital he was admitted for cardiac surgery, but died during the surgical procedure.			

The death certificate states that the immediate cause of death was myocardial infarction. The MSHA investigation did not reveal any environmental or physical conditions that contributed to the death.

Based on the death certificate and MSHA's investigation, I determined that the death of was not due to mine related work activities and should not be charged to the mining industry.
