The operator failed to immediately contact MSHA at once without delay and within 15 minutes of an explosion that occurred on 4-5-2010 at the Massey Energy's Upper Big Branch mine. Records indicate from recording devices recovered from the accident scene that at 15:02 an explosion occurred that resulted in the deaths of 29 miners. The MSHA call center received a call from the Marfork training center at 15:30 saying there was an air reversal on the belts with C/O concentrations between 50 and 100 parts per million. When asked by the call center operator if there were any deaths, injuries, fire or anyone trapped as a result of this condition, the answer was no. In a mine emergency that indicates potential catastrophic results, early notification to authorities would assist in the preservation of life and property. The operator has engaged in aggravated conduct constituting more
