I do not think this proposed rule revision will change the overall safety in surface mines. The inspections are already being carried out.

I believe that miner safety would be better enhanced by concentrating more resources in EFS to train miners on hazard recognition as hazards develop throughout the shift....not just prior to the shift starting as this proposed rule change is focused on. Miners who are trained by EFS to recognize hazards and the steps to mitigate the developing hazards are another resource to ensure that the mining environment is safe rather than placing all the burden on the mine operator.
