The #2 Continuous Miner, Joy S/N JM5574, used in the 2 Left Section located near Spad 4283 was not in permissible condition for the following reasons: 1) In the Central States Industries headlight, X/P-3612, S/N 5920, located on the off-side, the plugged gland was not tack-welded, and the lead entrance was not secured from loosening. 2) The guarding was broken (lense intact) on the Tri-plane style headlight, X/P-3190-0, located at the rear on the off-side. Also, both gland nuts were tightened down too far (both packing glands were not properly packed, in that less than 1/8" clearance existed between stuffing box and nut (Part 18.37(b)). In addition, one of the gland nuts was not secured from loosening (Part 18.37(c)). 3) And, on the mushroom e-stop on the off-side (X/P-4104-0), the enclosure housing was loose from the frame, and must be attached more securely.
