MSHA has established a program called the Voluntary Fire Suppression Agent Suitability Program (*See MSHA – Program Information Bulletin P11-17*). Under this program, “new or novel” fire suppression agents or devices used for manual fire fighting are evaluated. Fire fighting agents or devices found to be suitable under this program are assigned a “Suitability Number” by MSHA. Below is a list of products that were evaluated and found to be acceptable under the guidelines of the program.
