Machinery Hazard Alert

In 2011, 156 persons were injured working with machinery. These accidents represent 10 percent of those that occurred in the aggregates sector.









- > Always de-energize the power and block the equipment against hazardous motion before performing maintenance.
- > Follow lock and tag procedures for all energy sources, including electrical, mechanical, pneumatic, and hydraulic systems.
- > Always inspect machinery prior to use and take out of service immediately (and tag) if any safety defects are identified.
